






Directions

- ▶ On H-1 travel east
- ▶ Take exit **24A** to merge onto **Bingham St**
- ▶ Continue onto **Kalia St** for 249 ft
- ▶ Turn right onto **S Beretania St**
- OR ▶ Travel east on **S King St**
- ▶ Just before **University Ave**, make U-turn onto **S Beretania St**
- ▶ Destination will be on the right

- ▶ On H-1 travel west toward UH Manoa
- ▶ Take exit **25A** toward **King St/Waikiki Honolulu Zoo**
- ▶ Merge onto **Wai'alae Ave**
- ▶ Continue onto **S King St**
- ▶ Continue onto **S Beretania St**
- ▶ Destination will be on the right
