What is CZM Federal Consistency ?

National CZM Act requires that federal actions affecting any land or water use or natural resource of the coastal zone must be consistent with state CZM programs.

When is CZM Federal Consistency review required ?

- Federal Agency Activities
- Federal Permits and Licenses
- Outer Continental Shelf Activities
- Federal Grants and Loans

- Hawaii CZM Area = Entire Land Area and All Waters of the State
