Opportunities

• Affordable housing:

Deliberate policy to address targets through TOD on State lands, especially low AMI groups & affordable rental housing

- Incorporating <u>social infrastructure</u> (schools & services) in TOD planning & development
- Incorporating <u>alternative transportation modes</u> into rail & roadway investments to support walking, biking, etc.
- <u>Generating revenue</u> to State & State agencies on lands slated for TOD



Challenges & needs

- <u>Unified/coordinated approach</u> that melds State, County, private sector & community interests and provides:
 - <u>Strategic direction</u> on investments <u>as well as</u>
 - Project-specific coordination & problem-solving with

detailed, ongoing exchange of information & ideas between county, public utilities, other stakeholders at the table

• <u>Coordination/sharing of regional infrastructure</u> <u>investments</u> between State, counties, private



Challenges & needs

- <u>Committed source/s of funding</u> for TOD/SG & infrastructure investments
- Best practices:
 - TOD design
 - New tools for financing TOD & infrastructure
 - Hybrid TIFs, GET-TIFs, etc.
 - Linking State bonding authority with County recapture tools
 - Incentives for TOD
 - Private & smaller landowner participation
 - Incorporating sustainable development practices to address climate change
